Here's what you will need:

- **Brushes** #10 round synthetic, #6 round synthetic, 1' flat, 1/2 flat synthetic.
Do not buy cheap packs of brushes, they will loose hairs and drive you nuts
- **Palette knives** Assorted plastic or metal palette knives
- **Palette** Styro plates, yogurt lids, low Tupperware containers & large Ziploc baggies to take wet paint home
- **Paint** You may use craft acrylics i.e. Folk Art Brand, they will not have the same pigment quality that artist grade paint will; but they are much less expensive. If you plan to paint a lot, then use at least student grade acrylics i.e. Liquitex Basics.
Colours to buy: Titanium white
Cadmium yellow med
Alizarin crimson
Cadmium red light
Jenkins green (dark green)
Ceyan Blue (primary blue)
Diozanine purple
- **Surface** You can use paper, canvas, or canvas boards. If you use paper, use water colour paper, it's sturdier
- **Misc.** Paper towels, pencil, paper, ruler, eraser, container for rinsing brushes (yogurt container is fine)

For the Draw to Paint Class, please also add:

- **Graphite pencils** small assortment of soft & hard (H & B)

For your information: costs

- Brushes** Should be \$6 each. If you can afford more, pay more it makes a difference
- Paints** Craft acrylics \$1.69 each/Student grade \$7.99each/ Artist grade \$14.00 each - the more you pay the better the quality
- Palette knives** \$4.00 plastic set or \$ 8.00 each metal (they do last longer)
- Surface** Watercolour paper \$3.00 pack, canvas 16x20 \$12.99 for 2 (Michaels)
